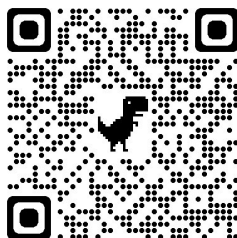

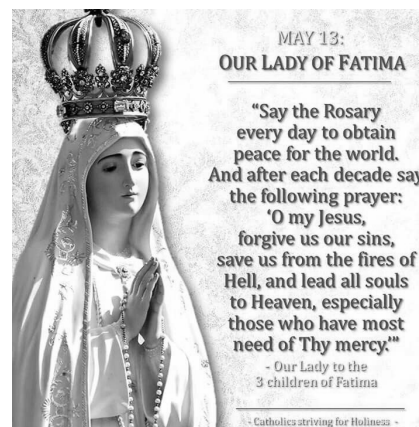
INTERNATIONAL MASS 10AM PENTECOST SUNDAY 5th JUNE 2022 -
