Attached to this newsletter is his letter to all parishioners who are worshipping Sunday by Sunday, inviting them to play their part in reaching out to fellow Catholics who no longer come to Mass - maybe family, friends, neighbours, colleagues, and there is a card from him on the newsletter table to those who have not returned to Mass, who are hesitant, or whose practice has come to a halt during the pandemic, inviting them to return. If there is someone you know who has not yet returned please take a card to give to them or alternatively let Fr. Hans know their name and address and a card can be sent on the parishes behalf inviting them to return.
